Sustainability and social impact are crucial goals for every MFI and have inspired the European Code of Good Conduct for Microcredit Provision: what is the current situation in the European sector about sustainable and replicable models? The session will focus on the practical experiences of some European leader MFIs which will present strength/weakness of its different business models (key factors of organization and success, social impact and its costs, net and gross sustainability and time to get there).

The workshop is organized in the framework of the Jasmine Initiative (Joint Action to Support Microfinance Institution in Europe - funded by the EC and the EIF), in partnership with Permicro and Fondazione Giordano dell'Amore. The event is addressed to high qualified policy makers/investors/stakeholders/experts/regulators who want to deeply understand how microfinance works in Europe and what they can do to support the sector.
